God Is at Work

Life was busy for a few months in terms of ministry, and I had no Sabbath rest. Then, I went to Melbourne for the Core Missionary Training from May 8-11 with our teams. It was such an inspiring and encouraging time! During Core Missionary Training I learnt how to be more effective in ministry and reflected on how I can survive long-term with a balance of life and good health. So a few weeks ago, I started to walk regularly after work, and even Ken and I are taking a break for a few hours each weekend. My energy level has improved and my heart is so glad.

Since August last year, I have been serving as an authorised full-time missionary. I am a local missionary but have the opportunity - through contact with international students - to reach out to the world. Up until now I have led 9 students: 5 boys and 4 girls from Hong Kong, China, Taiwan and Ecuador. I am continuing to disciple them. Two students were baptised last December and at Easter time this year. I currently lead 6 groups in Bible study.



I would like to share one story - about Ellen - and how her life was changed. I had the privilege of leading her to Christ last August. We did the Discovery Bible Study together and I disciple her in this way. I encouraged her to join our Beyond Brisbane Project Training and Breakthrough conference this year. She was baptised at Easter. I build up and train Ellen 4 days every week and get to see her grow. She is a very committed movement builder (MB) in terms of fulfilling the Great Commission. How exciting it was to see May make a decision to follow Christ through Ellen's ministry. We call May a 2nd generation believer. I helped Ellen lead May through the First Steps programme. Ellen also led non-believer Katie to the Discovery Bible Study.

Please pray for their life journey.

Three weeks ago, one of our students - Mike (Ken led him to Christ last October) came with me for the first time in sharing the Good News of the Gospel. He was scared to meet strangers. I said, "We prayed about doing evangelism. You do not need to be scared. Watch what I do." In fact, God was at work because we met Fred. We talked with Fred for a long time and he asked us what the difference is between Catholics and Protestants. I explained. Mike and I also shared our stories of how God has changed our lives. Finally, Fred made a decision to follow Christ. Now, I will help Mike lead Fred through the First Steps material. He will become rooted in God's words and bear fruit. Please pray for Mike and Fred.

Pray that he can raise fully support. Pray that God uses Ken and I powerfully on campus in His ministry.
3. Pray that God will protect our family physically, emotionally, and spiritually every day. Our son, Michael, has a busy life. We catch up together around once a month. Pray that Michael will experience Jesus Christ in his life.
