kindered heart from our US colleagues. It was a wonderful conference with 1200+ participants (students and staff) from 50+ nations sharing the vision and experience in campus ministry. As members of the



Australian team of 6 missionaries and 4 students, we have learnt from the US colleagues as well as promoted the AUS experience in international student ministry. God has

strengthened our partnership across the Pacific. We had a table to invite people to join the Sydney Summer Project in June this year. Conferenced finished on New Year day, over 20 students gave their lives to Christ.

Reunion with a mission friend, Emily in Los Angeles

We traveled to LA to catch up with a friend, whom we met in a Cambodian mission 10 years ago. The 2-day stay was memorable and far reaching. Our friends took us to Fuller Theological Seminary to attend



the semester inauguration service where we met the Dean of the School of Intercultural Studies who gave us a book about Asian Christianity to take back to BST.

Accompanied by Emily and Eugene, we watched sunset at Santa Monica and visited a Chinese C&MA church at San Gabriel Valley, the LA stay was a great sense of fellowship in déjà vu.

Then we came to Phoenix City to visit our BCQ alumnus Selma, and her husband Jerry who is the youth pastor of Greater Phoenix Chinese Christian Church (GPCCC). concluded with a Sunday service at GPCCC and our home return journey to Australia began the next day.

Upon returning home, we joined with our workers for a week (13-19 Jan) in the Power to Change national conference. The theme of the conference is "Fruitfulness". It was such an encouraging and inspiring week as we gathered together to



reconnect, to learn great teaching, to hear what God has been doing in our midst, and to celebrate the 50th anniversary of Power to Change missionary service in Australia. With 150+

missionary workers, we see the faithfulness of servants who serve for 5, 10, 20, 35, 40 years, and the thousands of believers coming to Christ, it is truly a manifestation of fruitfulness in Christian life and ministry. At this time, consolidating the previous learning and taking up new responsibility, Ken and Florence are embarking a new and renewed start in 2018 for our ministry.



Beyond Brisbane Project 2018

The Beyond Brisbane Project (4-16 Feb) has started at the time of this letter being written. 10 missionaries and 18 students join together to reach out international



students across the major universities in Brisbane during the orientation weeks in February. Our students will be equipped and trained by our missionaries with Gospel materials, evangelization training sessions and discipleship workshops. We will go out together to meet students on campuses and initiate spiritual conversations with the hope of a full gospel presentation in anticipation of a conscientious decision from the people to follow Christ.

Ministry Outlook of 2018

Before Beyond Brisbane kicked started, we had a missionary retreat in Redcliffe which gave us a good opportunity to regain strengths and to improve teamwork. As for personal



development plan and goals, Florence will focus in evangelizing and discipling new students as well as mentoring some key students. Ken in addition to student ministry, he will continue to develop faculty staff ministry with hope to reach out non-Christian staff.
