

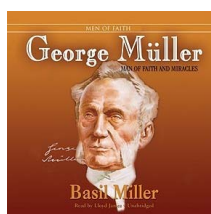
Dear Friends and Prayer Partners

We would like to greet you in our first newsletter of 2019 with the Bible passage Philippians 3:12:

“Not that I have already obtained all this, or have already arrived at my goal, but I press on to take hold of that for which Christ Jesus took hold of me.”

Pressing Toward the Goal

George Mueller (1805-1898), a Christian, pastor, social reformer, wrote in his devotion journal about a prayer:



“In Nov 1844, I began to pray for the conversion of 5 individuals. I prayed every day without a single intermission, whether sick or in health, on the land, on the sea, and whatever the pressure of my engagements might be...Day by day,

I continued to pray for them, and 6 years passed before the third was converted. I thanked God for the 3, and went on praying for the other 2.”

In 1880 these 2 individuals remained unconverted, Mueller wrote again 36 years later:

“But I hope in God, I pray on, and look for the answer. They re not converted yet, but they will be.”

In 1898, 53 years after Mueller began to pray, these 2 people were finally converted, one at Mueller's funeral and the other shortly thereafter. (Basil Miller, “George Mueller: Man of Faith”, 1943, p146)

We tell you this story as a reflection of us in pressing toward the goal for which God calls us in campus ministry. It is vitally important to be joyful in hope, patient in affliction, faithful in prayer (Romans 12:12). This is what we want to share with you in this newsletter.
